- 1) Don't leave it to others.

- 3) Create insect friendly habitats in the world of manicured lawns. Any area large or small is fine. Why mow or spray fence lines, driveways multiple times per year? Wouldn't it be great to ride down the roads of Marlborough on a sunny day listening to the humming sounds of pollinators going about their business, knowing you are taking part in supporting nature.

Out in the garden

Did you manage to take a break last month? With temperatures slowly rising it's time to reconnect with nature and get your hands dirty again in the garden. Jobs are plentiful and can be more fun if carried out together with someone you like. A toast to gardening: What a wonderful form of mind and body therapy.

- Clean out green house and propagation facilities
- Prepare the garden for spring planting, chop up and dig in cover crops, add plenty of compost
- Weed as necessary
- Sow seeds in trays ready for transplanting later
- Sow parsnip, turnip, Swedes, peas and broad beans
- Start sprouting seed potatoes ready for sowing
- Protect seedlings from slugs and snails.
- Fertilise fruit trees, Rhododendron, Camelia, Azaleas and Roses
- Finish pruning including roses
- Rake up the last of the winter leaves and start a new compost pile
