## Out in the garden

Spring is nearly upon us. Temperatures are slowly rising and the days are gradually getting longer. Now is as good a time as any to get your hands dirty and prepare the garden for spring planting!



- ♦ Weed and dig in compost and generous amounts of Daltons Landscape pellets or other organic fertiliser to prepare flower beds for spring planting.
- ♦ Feed trees and shrubs with a good layer of Daltons Mulch & Grow and Maxicrop Soil Conditioner to improve soil quality and your plant health.
- ♦ Plant asparagus crowns directly into the garden. For best results, plant in well draining soil rich in organic matter (compost).
- ♦ Prepare the vege garden for spring planting by digging in generous helpings of Daltons Compost and add Lime to improve soil structure.
- ♦ Moss can be a problem in poorly drained or shady areas of lawn. Improve lawn drainage by raking the area thoroughly and apply a solution of Sulphate of Iron (10g per square metre) to kill moss.

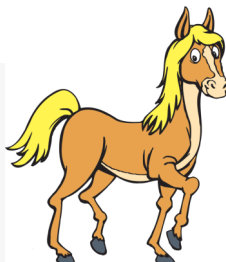
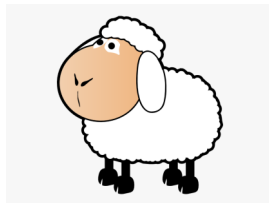
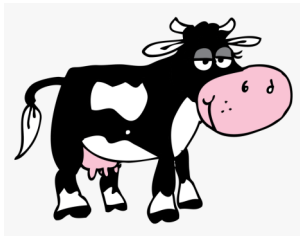
