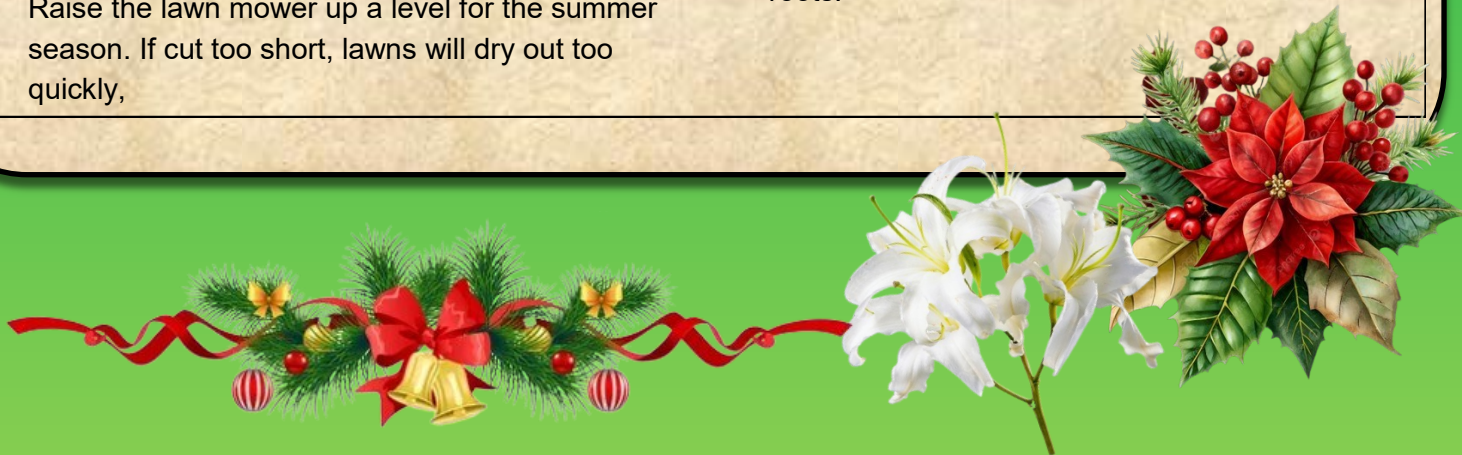

Tasks for December

- ◆ Feed tomatoes once a week. Remove laterals (side growths) on tall tomato varieties as they grow and ensure they are firmly staked. Water regularly.
- ◆ Courgettes and cucumbers can be protected from powdery mildew with a copper spray.
- ◆ Protect plants from caterpillars with Diatomaceous Earth.
- ◆ Raise the lawn mower up a level for the summer season. If cut too short, lawns will dry out too quickly,
- ◆ Water lawns in dry weather and apply fast acting lawn food such as Kiwi Seed Lawn Fertiliser to keep lawns fresh and green
- ◆ Remember that water is the lifeline of the veggie garden in summer. Plants are best watered in the morning or early evening, not during the heat of the day. Water deeply every few days rather than a little every day, as this encourages plants to develop deeper roots.
