Winter is also the ideal time to plant new fruit trees in your garden and orchard.

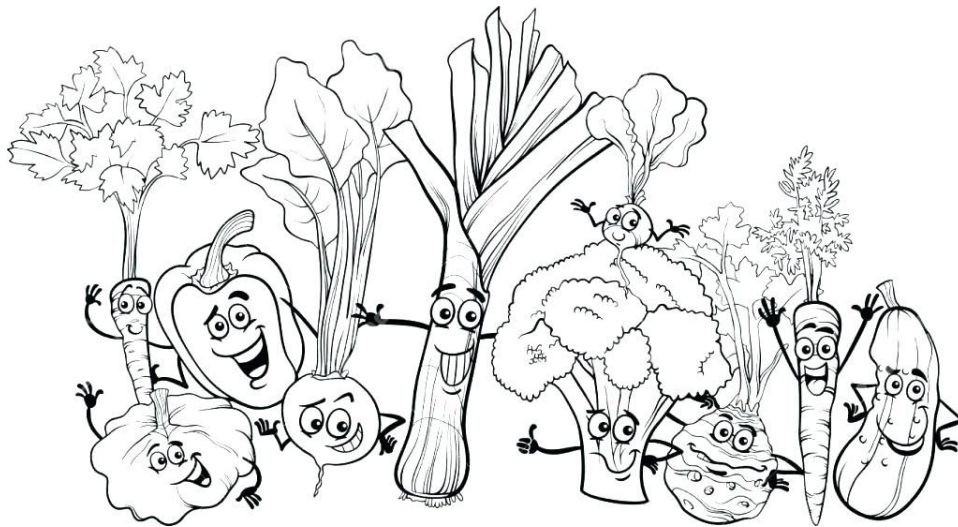
Plan your new growing season, this is the perfect time to involve the kids and grandchildren.

Undercover you can sow broccoli, rocket, silver beet and spinach.



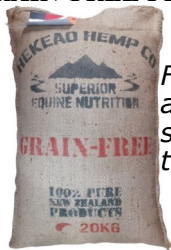
